The Clark County Department of Aviation (DOA) recognizes that the responsible management of the environment for our employees, tenants, and customers is a key element of a successful business strategy. As such, the DOA has committed to implementing policies and procedures that ensure compliance with applicable laws and regulations in conducting our operations. The following measures promote the ideals and practices of environmental responsibility at DOA facilities:

- Minimizing potential impacts to the environment by operating our facilities in a safe and prudent manner
- Conducting regular audits to ensure compliance with this policy
- Promoting the continued development of best management practices relating to sustainability
- Taking into account the principles of sustainable development whenever feasible
- Working to prevent adverse environmental impacts, reduce wastes, and promote conservation
- Promoting practices consistent with environmental protection by DOA employees
- Implementing a training program for DOA employees to raise awareness of environmental issues and enlist their support in conducting their activities in an environmentally responsible manner
- Improving environmental performance at DOA facilities by responsibly correcting conditions that are potentially harmful to the environment
- Responding to concerns and suggestions regarding environmental issues
- Encouraging the use of sound environmental principles and practices by vendors, tenants, and contractors

The DOA recognizes the need for responsible environmental management and conservation of resources within a global context and is therefore committed to reducing its impact on the environment by minimizing, preventing, and where possible, eliminating environmental risks, hazards, and concerns. Compliance with environmental laws, regulations, and DOA environmental policies is mandatory and is a basic responsibility of everyone conducting activities at DOA facilities.
