## PLATES ISSUED BY STATE OF NEVADA EXEMPT FROM PARKING FEES

NRS 482.3765 Veteran of Armed Forces of United States who survived attack on Pearl Harbor. [Effective on the earlier of July 1, 2018, or the date on which the Director of the Department of Motor Vehicles notifies the Governor and the Director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau that sufficient resources are available to enable the Department to carry out the provisions of chapter 62, Statutes of Nevada 2015, at page 262.

- 2. A person who qualifies for special license plates pursuant to this section, has suffered a qualifying service-connected disability as a result of his or her service in the Armed Forces of the United States and receives compensation from the United States for the disability is entitled to have his or her special license plates issued pursuant to this section inscribed with the international symbol of access, which must comply with any applicable federal standards and must be white on a blue background.
- 5. A vehicle on which license plates issued by the Department pursuant to subsection 2 are displayed is exempt from the payment of any parking fees, including those collected through parking meters, charged by the State or any political subdivision or other public body within the State, other than the United States.

NRS 482.377 "Disabled Veteran," "Disabled Female Veteran" or "Veteran Who Is Disabled" and "Ex-Prisoner of War." [Effective on the earlier of July 1, 2018, or the date on which the Director of the Department of Motor Vehicles notifies the Governor and the Director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau that sufficient resources are available to enable the Department to carry out the provisions of chapter 62, Statutes of Nevada 2015, at page 262.]

- 1. A veteran of the Armed Forces of the United States who, as a result of his or her service:
- (a) Has suffered a 100-percent service-connected disability and who receives compensation from the United States for the disability is entitled to specially designed license plates that must be inscribed with:
- (1) The words "DISABLED VETERAN," "DISABLED FEMALE VETERAN" or "VETERAN WHO IS DISABLED," at the option of the veteran;
- 5. A vehicle on which license plates issued by the Department pursuant to this section are displayed is exempt from the payment of any parking fees, including those collected through parking meters, charged by the State or any political subdivision or other public body within the State, other than the United States.

NRS 482.3775 Veteran of Armed Forces of United States awarded Purple Heart. [Effective until the earlier of July 1, 2018, or the date on which the Director of the Department of Motor Vehicles notifies the Governor and the Director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau that sufficient resources are available to enable the Department to carry out the provisions of chapter 62, Statutes of Nevada 2015, at page 262.]

- 2. A person who qualifies for special license plates pursuant to this section, has suffered a qualifying service-connected disability as a result of his or her service in the Armed Forces of the United States and receives compensation from the United States for the disability is entitled to have his or her special license plates issued pursuant to this section inscribed with the international symbol of access, which must comply with any applicable federal standards and must be white on a blue background.

[Effective on the earlier of July 1, 2018, or the date on which the Director of the Department of Motor Vehicles notifies the Governor and the Director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau that sufficient resources are available to enable the Department to carry out the provisions of chapter 62, Statutes of Nevada 2015, at page 262.]

- 2. A person who qualifies for special license plates pursuant to this section, has suffered a qualifying service-connected disability as a result of his or her service in the Armed Forces of the United States and receives compensation from the United States for the disability is entitled to have his or her special license plates issued pursuant to this section inscribed with the international symbol of access, which must comply with the applicable federal standards and must be white on a blue background.
- 5. Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, a vehicle on which license plates issued by the Department pursuant to subsection 2 are displayed is exempt from the payment of any parking fees, including, without limitation, those collected through parking meters, charged by the State or any political subdivision or other public body within this State, other than the United States.

Allows the plate holder to use handicapped parking.

Exempts vehicle from Nevada state and local parking fees.



## **Ex-Prisoner of War**

Must have official Ex-POW status.

Exempts vehicle from Nevada state and local parking fees.



## **Bronze Star (with valor)**

Must have General Order of the award.

Disabled version exempts vehicle from Nevada state and local parking fees.



#### Silver Star

Must have General Order of the award.

Disabled version exempts vehicle from Nevada state and local parking fees.



# SURVIVOR Home Means Nevada

## **Pearl Harbor Survivor**

<u>Pearl Harbor Survivors Association</u> membership or proof of duty station.

Disabled version exempts vehicle from Nevada state and local parking fees.



## **Pearl Harbor Veteran**

Pearl Harbor Survivors Association membership or proof of duty station.

Disabled version exempts vehicle from Nevada state and local parking fees.



## Congressional Medal of Honor

Available to Medal recipients.

Disabled version exempts vehicle from Nevada state and local parking fees.



## **Purple Heart**

Available to medal recipients.

Disabled version exempts vehicle from Nevada state and local parking fees.
