II. ACTION ITEMS - PUBLIC HEARINGS

A. V0110 Marriott (Hotel Tower)

Application for a variance from the Airport Hazard Height limitations to allow the proposed structure on the SW corner of Paradise Road and Convention Center Drive (APN# 162-09-806-001, -005, -006, -007, -008 and -011) to extend as much as 2,720 feet above mean sea level (AMSL), 671 feet above ground level (AGL). When built as proposed, the FAA has determined that the structure would penetrate the FAR Part 77 Surfaces as follows:

Section 77.23 (a) (1) by 171 feet – a height more than 500 feet above ground level.

Section 77.23 (a) (2) by 339 feet - a height that exceeds 2382 feet above mean sea level within 3.00 nautical miles of LAS.

Section 77.23 (a) (3) by 307 feet – a height that increases a minimum instrument flight altitude within a terminal area (TERPS Criteria). The proposal would necessitate the increase of Proposed building penetrates the departure surface at LAS. This building will become the final approach controlling obstacle for the RNAV (GPS) RWY 19R and RNAV (GPS) RWY 19L. Penetrates the RWY 01L diverse departure surface by 306.26 feet with (2C) accuracy code, 356.97 feet with (4D).

Section 77.23 (a) (5) a height that affects an Airport Surface by penetrating Section 77.25 (b) Conical Surface by 324 feet - as applied to LAS.
